2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 46 am
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 TENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to the sale of surplus pipeline
6 equipment in Alaska.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS Alaska is experiencing a period of growth and development which
9 has caused and will continue to cause a heavy demand for construction pro-
10 jects in the public and private sectors; and

11 WHEREAS construction costs in Alaska are among the highest in the world
12 and contribute significantly to the high cost of living here; and

13 WHEREAS construction costs could be significantly lowered, and all
14 Alaskans thereby benefited, if the surplus construction equipment used on the
15 trans-Alaska pipeline could be sold in Alaska;

16 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature requests the Governor
17 to use all the influence at his command to persuade Alyeska Pipeline Service
18 Company to sell its surplus equipment in Alaska, giving preference to sales
19 at the sites where the equipment is located.
