5 Honoring the memory of Victor V. Gill.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 The recent death of Victor V. Gill ends the long and distinguished life  
8 of a truly remarkable Alaskan pioneer.

9 He came to Alaska as an infant with his parents in 1907 where they  
10 settled at Susitna Station. His father entered public life to serve in the  
11 Territorial Legislature and was the Speaker of the House during the Eigh-  
12 teenth Territorial Legislature.

13 Victor Gill, following the example set by his father, was concerned with  
14 making government work and as a result became a city councilman for the City  
15 of Anchorage from 1944 to 1946, a member of the Anchorage Planning and Zoning  
16 Commission, the Advisory Budget Committee for the City of Anchorage, and the  
17 state Local Boundary Commission.

18 Those who knew Victor Gill now feel a deep personal loss. He set an  
19 example of unselfish giving of his time and talents for better state and  
20 local government. The legislature expresses its most sincere condolences to  
21 his sons, Larry, Russell, and Gregory, and his daughters Christine Gill and  
22 Louise Fredrickson, on behalf of its members and the people of Alaska.
