5 Relating to the office of the ombudsman.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS the vast majority of state employees are hard-working, dedicated
8 servants of the people of the State of Alaska; and

9 WHEREAS the functions of the state's public servants are imperative to
10 the well-being of the people of the State of Alaska; and

11 WHEREAS the position of the ombudsman was created to provide unslanted
12 and factual information to the public of Alaska; and

13 WHEREAS the ombudsman's office appears to have found it necessary to
14 resort to ridicule and slander, and to subject all state employees to embar-
15 rassment; and

16 WHEREAS Alaskan tax dollars should not be spent for the questionable
17 purpose of poking fun at state employees for the sole reason of inducing
18 complaints;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature deplores the implica-
20 tions of stereotyping of state employees by the ombudsman's office; and be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED that the office of the ombudsman is directed to im-
22 mediately desist from such actions and henceforth to perform its authorized
23 functions in an unbiased and professional manner.
