5 Relating to the composition of boards and
6 commissions.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the size of state government has increased over the recent years;
9 and

10 WHEREAS this increased size has resulted in numerous boards and commis-
11 sions which affect a wide range of issues and activities of importance to the
12 people of the state; and

13 WHEREAS the large number of boards and commissions makes it difficult for
14 the people to keep up with their changes in membership; and

15 WHEREAS it is important, in maintaining the high quality of public per-
16 sonnel and their responsiveness to the needs of the public, to encourage the
17 expression of public opinion relating to the composition of the boards and
18 commissions; and

19 WHEREAS to provide informed opinions, the citizens must have a convenient
20 way of determining the membership of boards and commissions; and

21 WHEREAS there is currently no such convenient method;

22 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is
23 respectfully requested to maintain a current list of the members of the boards
24 and commissions in the state government; and be it

25 FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to notify
26 the legislature and the public in an appropriate and expeditious manner of
27 changes made in the list.
