2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 81

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 TENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to a Youth in Government program.

6 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

7 WHEREAS the participation of youth in the processes of state government  
8 is essential in maintaining an involved and educated citizenry; and

9 WHEREAS the opportunity for participation has been presented to youths  
10 in other states through the Youth in Government program sponsored by the Young  
11 Men's Christian Association, and

12 WHEREAS the Youth in Government program has not been available to Alaska's  
13 youth in the past; and

14 WHEREAS the encouragement of the legislature and the governor for the  
15 establishment of a Youth in Government program could assist in bringing the  
16 opportunity to Alaska's youth for learning about and becoming involved in the  
17 operations of their state government;

18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Young Men's  
19 Christian Association is encouraged and respectfully requested to initiate a  
20 Youth in Government program for Alaska's youth; and be it

21 FURTHER RESOLVED that the legislature commits itself to making the facil-  
22 ities of the legislature available for the Youth in Government program during  
23 the weekend of February 10 - 12, 1979; and be it

24 FURTHER RESOLVED that the governor is respectfully requested to assist  
25 in the initiation of the Youth in Government program in Alaska by making avail-  
26 able to that program the facilities of the governor's office during the week-  
27 end of February 10 - 12, 1979.
