4 TENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Relating to the movement of the division  
6 of highways laboratory from Fairbanks.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the testing laboratory for the state highway department has been  
9 located at the University of Alaska for twenty years; and

10 WHEREAS the laboratory is centrally located in relation to the highway  
11 system it serves; and

12 WHEREAS location of the laboratory within the University of Alaska  
13 engineering complex gives laboratory workers access to facilities which are  
14 not available elsewhere; and

15 WHEREAS the costs of moving the laboratory outside Fairbanks would not  
16 result in any return which would justify the expense; and

17 WHEREAS Fairbanks and interior Alaska are currently depressed areas of  
18 employment and the relocation of the laboratory would add to the unemployment  
19 of the area;

20 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature respectfully requests  
21 the Governor to direct the Commissioner of Transportation and Public Facili-  
22 ties to halt the relocation of the laboratory.
