2 SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 104

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 TENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Requesting the Board of Fisheries to
6 convene a special meeting.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the Board of Fisheries has recently acted to cancel the sche-
9 duled king salmon sport fishing season in the upper Cook Inlet; and

10 WHEREAS the king salmon sport fishery in this area has been closed for
11 five years; and

12 WHEREAS there has been a steady increase in the salmon run sufficient
13 to convince the board to previously schedule an opening in the fishery during
14 1978; and

15 WHEREAS it is not clear what new biological justification formed the
16 basis for the reversal of the board's previous action; and

17 WHEREAS sport fishermen in the Anchorage area are extremely concerned
18 about the board's recent decision;

19 BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Board of
20 Fisheries is urgently requested to convene a special meeting for the purpose
21 of reconsidering their action in canceling the scheduled king salmon sport
22 fishing season in the upper Cook Inlet.
