2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 1
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 TENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Proposing an amendment to the state
6 constitution limiting regular sessions
7 of the legislature to 90 days.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. Article II, sec. 8, Constitution of the State of Alaska is
10 amended to read:

11 SECTION 8. The legislature shall convene each year on the fourth
12 Monday in January, but the month and day may be changed by law. Regular
13 sessions are limited to ninety days. The legislature may extend the
14 session for a period not to exceed twenty days by a concurrent resolu-
15 tion approved by a majority vote of the membership of each house; and
16 an additional period not to exceed ten days by a concurrent resolution
17 approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the membership of each house.

18 * Sec. 2. The amendment proposed by this resolution shall be placed
19 before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity
20 with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election
21 laws of the state.
