2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 13

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 TENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Relating to social and economic relations
6 with the Republic of China.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 WHEREAS the Republic of China has been a continuous and faithful ally of
9 the United States, supplying both moral and economic support to the benefit
10 of both nations; and

11 WHEREAS the Republic of China has made every effort to develop a free
12 enterprise-based democratic form of government; and

13 WHEREAS the Republic of China has pledged its human and economic re-
14 sources to the defense of free people everywhere; and

15 WHEREAS the cultural interchange between the Republic of China and the
16 United States has benefited both nations;

17 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature strongly urges that the
18 President and Congress of the United States make every effort to develop
19 better social and economic relations with the Republic of China.

20 COPIES of this resolution shall be sent to the Honorable Jimmy Carter,
21 President of the United States; and to the Honorable Ted Stevens and the
22 Honorable Mike Gravel, U.S. Senators, and the Honorable Don Young, U.S.
23 Representative, members of the Alaska delegation in Congress.
