2 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 30
3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
4 TENTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

5 Proposing amendments to the Constitution
6 of the State of Alaska relating to regular
7 and special sessions of the legislature.

8 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. Article II, sec. 8, Constitution of the State of Alaska is
10 amended to read:

11 SECTION 8. REGULAR SESSIONS. The legislature shall convene each
12 year on the fourth Monday in January, but the month and day may be
13 changed by law. Regular sessions are limited to ninety days.

14 * Sec. 2. Article II, sec. 9, Constitution of the State of Alaska is
15 amended to read:

16 SECTION 9. SPECIAL SESSIONS. Special sessions may be called by
17 the governor or by vote of two-thirds of the legislators. The vote may
18 be conducted by the legislative council or as prescribed by law. At
19 special sessions called by the governor, legislation shall be limited to
20 subjects designated in his proclamation calling the session or to
21 subjects presented by him. At a special session called by vote of two-
22 thirds of the legislators or by the governor, and convened four days
23 following the adjournment of a regular or another special session,
24 legislation shall be limited to subjects designated in the call by con-
25 current resolution of the legislature or by request of the governor.

26 Special sessions are limited to thirty days; however, there is no limit
27 on the number of special sessions which may be held if the procedures
28 of this section for calling special sessions are complied with.

29 * Sec. 3. The amendments proposed by this resolution shall be placed

1 before the voters of the state at the next general election in conformity
2 with art. XIII, sec. 1, Constitution of the State of Alaska, and the election
3 laws of the state.
