8 BE IT RESOLVED THE THE SENATE:

9 WHEREAS the Alaska Court System has designed a project calling for the
10 development of new methods and procedures in the judicial system aimed toward
11 making the system less complex and costly and more responsive to the needs of
12 the public for dispute resolution mechanisms; and

13 WHEREAS the Alaska Court System has submitted a proposal for funding of
14 the project to the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration; and

15 WHEREAS the Law Enforcement Assistance Administration recently sent a
16 task force to Alaska to investigate the feasibility of implementing this
17 proposal in Alaska and this task force has concluded that Alaskans would be
18 receptive to the changes that may be developed in the course of the project;

19 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Senate finds that this project would
20 contribute to the administration of justice in Alaska and urges the Law
21 Enforcement Assistance Administration to provide necessary funding.

23 Velde, Administrator, Law Enforcement Assistance Administration, to the
24 Alaska Governor's Commission on the Administration of Justice, and to the
25 Honorable Ted Stevens and the Honorable Mike Gravel, U.S. Senators, and to
26 the Honorable Don Young, U.S. Representative, members of the Alaska delega-
27 tion in Congress, and to the Honorable Warren E. Burger, Chief Justice,
