12 distance and the expense of travel from the Aleutians to the mainland pre-  
13 cludes pre-tournament engagements with other schools having competition in  
14 sports. This year the "Eaglettes" from Adak earned special recognition at  
15 the Alaskan Girls Region III Basketball Tournament at Cordova which does  
16 credit to the "Eaglettes" team members collectively and individually and  
17 their coach.

20 and Linda York who won the Sportsmanship Trophy at the tournament, players
