3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 TENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 Supporting construction of a small boat
6 moorage basin at Anchorage.

7 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

8 WHEREAS no small boat moorage basin currently exists in the Anchorage
9 area where small boats may be moored; and

10 WHEREAS persons who own small boats must presently either moor their
11 boats in Homer, Kenai, or Valdez or must remove their boats from the water
12 after each use due to the absence of local facilities; and

13 WHEREAS the York Steel Company, Inc., has submitted an application to
14 the United States Department of Army, Corps of Engineers, for a permit to
15 construct a small boat moorage basin south of Ship Creek at Anchorage; and

16 WHEREAS the York Steel Company, Inc., proposal contains many desirable
17 features, including 1,600 lineal feet of dock space available at all tides, a
18 shop to support maintenance or repair work on vessels, a rail siding, and
19 warehouse capacity for temporary storage of material or cargo; and

20 WHEREAS these facilities will be readily accessible to downtown Anchorage
21 and will be of benefit for commercial and recreational uses; and

22 WHEREAS the York Steel Company, Inc., proposal has, to date, been under-
23 way for five years solely at the expense of private businessmen with no
24 public expenditures of any kind;

25 BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Senate supports the York Steel
26 Company, Inc., proposal and respectfully requests the Alaska District Corps
27 of Engineers to issue the York Steel Company, Inc., a permit to construct
28 these facilities.
