6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to election ballots."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 15.15.030(5) is amended to read:

9 (5) The general election ballot shall be printed on white  
10 paper on one surface only. The [WITH THE] names of the candidates and  
11 their party designations shall be placed in separate sections under the  
12 office designation to which they were nominated. The party affiliation,  
13 if any, shall be designated after the name of the candidate. The  
14 lieutenant governor and the governor shall be included under the same  
15 section. Provision shall be made for voting for write-in and no-party  
16 candidates within each section. The squares appearing on the ballots  
17 shall measure 1/4 inch on each side.

18 \* Sec. 2. AS 15.15.030(13) is amended to read:

19 (13) The lieutenant governor may provide for the use of  
20 punch-card voting in state elections in any area where data processing  
21 equipment is available. Only one surface of a punch-card may be used  
22 for punch-card voting.
