6 For an Act entitled: "An Act appropriating for supplemental operating and
7 capital expenses of the state government and making
8 transfers between appropriations; and providing for an
9 effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 EDUCATION

12 * Section 1. The sum of \$459,300 is appropriated from the general fund to
13 the Department of Education, Alaska Arts Council, for payment as a grant to
14 the Alaska Repertory Theatre to meet budget deficits incurred on tours, loss
15 of estimated income, and to meet cash reserve requirements for the fiscal
16 year ending June 30, 1980.

17 * Sec. 2. The sum of \$54,600 is appropriated from the general fund to the
18 Department of Education for payment as a grant to the Anchorage current
19 events society for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1980.

20 * Sec. 3. The sum of \$20,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the
21 Department of Education for payment as a grant to the guidance department of
22 the Juneau-Douglas High School for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1980.
