6 For an Act entitled: "An Act limiting the effective period of administrative
7 regulations having the effect of law."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.03.010(c) is amended to read:

10 (c) Upon termination, each board listed in (a) and (b) of this
11 section shall continue in existence until June 30 of the next succeeding
12 year for the purpose of concluding its affairs. Administrative regula-
13 tions adopted by a board expire six months following the termination
14 date established for that board. [DURING THIS PERIOD, TERMINATION DOES
15 NOT REDUCE OR OTHERWISE LIMIT THE POWERS OR AUTHORITY OF EACH BOARD.]
16 One year after the date of termination, a board not continued shall
17 cease all activities.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 44.62.290(b) is amended to read:

19 (b) Only this section, [AND] AS 44.62.180 and 44.62.295 apply to
20 (1) a regulation which prescribes the organization or proce-
21 dure of an agency, or
22 (2) (repealed).

23 * Sec. 3. AS 44.62 is amended by adding a new section to read:

24 Sec. 44.62.295. LIMITATION ON EFFECTIVE PERIOD OF REGULATION. No
25 regulation adopted by an agency remains in effect longer than four
26 years.
