6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to powdered alcohol."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 43.60.010 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

9 (c) For the purpose of calculating the tax imposed by (a) of this
10 section, the Department of Revenue shall convert the weight of powdered
11 distilled spirits and powdered distilled spirit products to equivalent
12 liquid volume.

13 * Sec. 2. AS 43.60 is amended by adding a new section to read:

14 Sec. 43.60.050. DEFINITIONS. As used in this chapter "liquor" and
15 "intoxicating liquor" includes powdered distilled spirits and powdered
16 distilled spirit products.

17 * Sec. 3. AS 04.20.010 is amended to read:

18 Sec. 04.20.010. INTOXICATING LIQUOR DEFINED. As used in this
19 title, "intoxicating liquor" includes whiskey, brandy, rum, gin, wine,
20 ale, porter, beer, powdered distilled spirits and powdered distilled
21 spirit products and all other spirituous, vinous, malt and other fer-
22 mented or distilled liquors intended for human consumption and contain-
23 ing more than one per cent alcohol by volume.
