6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to motor vehicle registration plates;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 28.10.101(1) is amended to read:

10 (1) Until December 31, 1978, every vehicle registration
11 [REGISTERED AND EVERY REGISTRATION PLATE ISSUED] under this chapter
12 expires at midnight on December 31 of each year. The owner of a
13 registered vehicle may drive the vehicle under the registration for
14 the preceding year until May 31 of the year for which the registration
15 is required.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 28.10.105(a) is amended to read:

17 (a) Effective at midnight on December 31, 1978 [JANUARY 1,
18 1979], every vehicle registration and [,] registration card expire
19 [AND REGISTRATION PLATE EXPIRES] and must be renewed in accordance
20 with the registration renewal schedule set out in this section.

21 * Sec. 3. AS 28.10.161(a) is amended to read:

22 (a) Except as provided in sec. 181(i) of this chapter, the
23 department, upon registering a vehicle, shall issue the owner one
24 [FULLY] reflectorized registration plate for a trailer or a motorcycle
25 and two [FULLY] reflectorized registration plates for every other
26 vehicle. Except as specifically provided in sec. 181 of this chapter,
27 the plate or plates shall remain with the vehicle as long as the
28 vehicle is subject to registration under this chapter.

29 * Sec. 4. AS 28.10.161(b) is amended to read:

1 (b) Each year after the effective date of this Act when the
2 department reissues all passenger vehicle registration plates [AFTER
3 JANUARY 1, 1979], every passenger vehicle registration plate, except
4 as specifically provided in sec. 181 of this chapter, shall have
5 displayed upon it

6 (1) the Alaska flag;

7 (2) the traditional colors of yellow-gold and blue;

8 (3) the slogan "The Last Frontier";

9 (4) the registration number assigned to the vehicle for
10 which it is issued;

11 (5) the name of this state which may be abbreviated; and

12 (6) the registration year number or expiration date for
13 which it is validated; the registration year number or expiration date
14 may be part of the license plate or contained on a suitable sticker or
15 tab device issued by the department.

16 * Sec. 5. This Act is retroactive to December 31, 1978.

17 * Sec. 6. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-
18 10.070(c).
