5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making supplemental appropriations to the  
7 Departments of Education, Labor and Health and Social  
8 Services, to the University of Alaska, and to legisla-  
9 tive agencies; and providing for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. The sum of \$150,000 is appropriated from the general fund to  
12 the Department of Education, division of vocational rehabilitation, to pro-  
13 vide funds for continued current levels of operations.

14 \* Sec. 2. The sum of \$48,242 is appropriated from the general fund to the  
15 Department of Health and Social Services, division of social services, to be  
16 paid as a grant to the Anchorage Child Abuse Board, Inc.

17 \* Sec. 3. The sum of \$85,170 is appropriated from the general fund to the  
18 Department of Health and Social Services, division of social services, to be  
19 paid as a grant to the Studio Club.

20 \* Sec. 4. The sum of \$29,400 is appropriated from the general fund to the  
21 Department of Health and Social Services, division of social services, for  
22 five temporary social worker II positions and one temporary social worker IV  
23 position in the Southcentral Region to be used as child protection workers.

24 \* Sec. 5. The sum of \$27,210 is appropriated from the general fund to the  
25 Department of Health and Social Services, division of social services, to be  
26 paid as a grant to the Fairbanks Child Protection Task Force.

27 \* Sec. 6. The sum of \$70,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the  
28 Department of Health and Social Services, division of social services, to be  
29 paid as a grant to the Fairbanks Rehabilitation Association, Inc. for the

1 Hope Industries Division.

2 \* Sec. 7. The sum of \$8,000 is appropriated from the training and  
3 building fund to the Department of Labor, division of employment security,  
4 for rent and utilities for an employment center at Tok.

5 \* Sec. 8. The sum of \$320,000 is appropriated from the general fund to  
6 the Legislative Affairs Agency to be allocated as follows:

9	Rural Energy Committee - low-cost energy consumer

16 \* Sec. 9. The sum of \$277,500 is appropriated from the general fund to  
17 the Legislative Affairs Agency, for unbudgeted expenses and costs of the 1979  
18 legislative session.

19 \* Sec. 10. The sum of \$180,125 is appropriated from the general fund to  
20 the Legislative Budget and Audit Committee to be allocated as follows:

21	Legislative finance division - unbudgeted expenses	
22	and costs of the 1979 legislative session	\$130,125
23	Committee - increased FY 79 operating expenses	50,000

24 \* Sec. 11. The sum of \$86,100 is appropriated from the general fund to  
25 the Administrative Regulation Review Committee for operating expenses.

26 \* Sec. 12. The sum of \$56,000 is appropriated from the general fund to  
27 the University of Alaska - Anchorage for sponsorship of the national basket-  
28 ball tournament "The Great Alaskan Shoot Out."

29 \* Sec. 13. The sum of \$120,000 is appropriated from the general fund to

1 the Department of Education to begin construction of school facilities in  
 2 Allakaket. Insurance proceeds received as a result of the school fire on  
 3 January 25, 1979, shall lapse into the general fund upon receipt.

4 \* Sec. 14. The sum of \$197,500 is appropriated from the general fund to  
 5 the Department of Education for the Alaska Public Broadcasting Commission to  
 6 be used for community television as follows:

3 \* Sec. 15. The sum of \$30,000 is appropriated from the general fund to  
4 the Department of Health and Social Services to be paid as a grant to Meals  
5 On Wheels, Inc., Anchorage.

6 \* Sec. 16. The unexpended portion of the appropriation made in sec. 1 of  
7 this Act lapses into the general fund upon receipt by the division of voca-  
8 tional rehabilitation of amounts in excess of the appropriation for fiscal  
9 year 1979 made under section 110 of the Vocational Rehabilitation Act of 1973  
10 (P.L. 95-602) before June 30, 1979.

11 \* Sec. 17. The unexpended and unobligated portion of the appropriations  
12 made in secs. 2 - 6, 9, 10 and 15 of this Act lapse into the general fund on  
13 June 30, 1979.

14 \* Sec. 18. The unexpended and unobligated portion of the appropriation  
15 made in sec. 7 of this Act shall lapse into the training and building fund on  
16 June 30, 1980.

17 \* Sec. 19. The unexpended and unobligated portion of the appropriation  
18 made in sec. 12 of this Act lapses into the general fund on June 30, 1980.

19 \* Sec. 20. The appropriations contained in secs. 8 and 11 of this Act are  
20 allocated to various interim committees of the legislature, each lasting the  
21 duration of this legislature. The unexpended and unobligated portion of the  
22 appropriations made in secs. 8 and 11 of this Act lapse into the general fund  
23 on December 31, 1980.

24 \* Sec. 21. The appropriations contained in secs. 13 and 14 of this Act  
25 are for capital projects and are subject to the provisions of AS 37.25.020.

26 \* Sec. 22. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-  
27 070(c).
