6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to campaign disclosure and conflicts
7 of interest."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.50.040(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) A public official may transfer all or a portion of his assets
11 to a blind trust for the duration of his service in public office. [THE
12 ORIGINAL ASSETS PLACED IN THE BLIND TRUST SHALL BE LISTED BY THE OFFI-
13 CIAL IN THE STATEMENT REQUIRED TO BE FILED UNDER THIS CHAPTER. THE
14 INSTRUMENT CREATING THE BLIND TRUST MUST BE INCLUDED WITH THE STATE-
15 MENT.]

16 * Sec. 2. AS 39.50.040(b)(5) is amended to read:

17 (5) the trustee shall be required to report any known breach
18 of confidentiality or the termination of the trust to the attorney
19 general [OFFICE WHERE THE TRUSTOR IS REQUIRED TO FILE STATEMENTS UNDER
20 THIS CHAPTER]; and

21 * Sec. 3. AS 39.50.060(b) is amended to read:

22 (b) A person who violates a provision [ANY PERSON FAILING TO OR
23 REFUSING TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS] of this chapter, in addition
24 to the penalties prescribed, shall forfeit his nomination to office and
25 shall not be seated or installed in office [IF HE HAS NOT COMPLIED.
26 NOMINATED, HIRED, OR APPOINTED OFFICIALS, COMMISSIONERS, CHAIRMEN OR
27 MEMBERS OF COMMISSIONS OR BOARDS SPECIFIED IN AS 39.50.200(9) SHALL NOT
28 BE CONFIRMED BY THE LEGISLATURE IF COMPLIANCE HAS NOT BEEN MADE. IN THE
29 CASE OF ELECTED OFFICIALS, THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR, OR OTHER CERTIFYING

1 AUTHORITY, SHALL NOT CERTIFY A PERSON'S NOMINATION FOR OFFICE OR HIS
2 ELECTION TO OFFICE IF COMPLIANCE WAS NOT MADE WITHIN THE TIME REQUIRED.
3 THE NOMINATION TO OFFICE OR ELECTION TO OFFICE SHALL BE CERTIFIED TO THE
4 HIGHEST VOTE GETTER FOR THAT NOMINATION FOR THAT OFFICE OR ELECTION TO
5 THAT OFFICE WHO HAS COMPLIED WITHIN THE TIMES REQUIRED AND WHO SHALL BE
6 DECLARED NOMINATED OR ELECTED].
