6 For an Act entitled: " An Act relating to unemployment compensation for non-  
7 professional school employees; and providing for an  
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 23.20.375(c) is amended to read:

11 (c) Benefits based on service in employment defined in AS 23.20.-  
12 525(a)(4), (5), (6) and (14) are payable in the same amount, on the same  
13 terms and subject to the same conditions as compensation payable on the  
14 basis of other service subject to this chapter; except that, effective  
15 January 1, 1978, benefits based on service in an instructional, research  
16 or principal administrative capacity for an educational institution  
17 and, effective July 1, 1979, service in any other capacity for an educa-  
18 tional institution other than an institution of higher education may not  
19 be paid to an individual for a [ANY] week of unemployment which begins  
20 during the period between two successive academic years, or during a  
21 similar period between two regular terms, whether or not successive, or  
22 during a period of paid sabbatical leave provided for in the indivi-  
23 dual's contract, if the individual performs services in the first of  
24 those academic years or terms and if there is a contract or reasonable  
25 assurance that the individual will perform services in the same or a  
26 similar capacity for any educational institution in the second of those  
27 academic years or terms.
