6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to beverage dispensary and retail
7 liquor licenses."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 04.10.040 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (c) If the holder of a beverage dispensary license is also the
11 holder of a retail license and if the premises of the beverage dispen-
12 sary are connected to the premises of the retail license by a door or
13 other means of direct passage not available to the public, the holder of
14 the beverage dispensary license may also sell for cash intoxicating
15 liquor in the original packages and wine in bulk for consumption off the
16 premises. All liquor requiring Internal Revenue strip stamps shall have
17 the stamps intact on the packages. Sales under this subsection are
18 limited to less than 20 wine gallons to any one person in any one sale.
