7 civil liability of licensees under AS 04; and providing
8 that the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board determine
9 need for added entrances to certain retail store

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 04.10.040 is amended by adding a new section to article 1

Sec. 04.10.147. ENTRANCE TO PREMISES OF HOLDER OF RETAIL AND

15

BEVERAGE DISPENSARY LICENSES. When the holder of a retail license is

16

also a holder of a beverage dispensary license and the retail store

17

premises are contained within or adjacent to the premises of the bever-

18

age dispensary and the only public entrance to the retail store is by a

19

door or other means within the premises of the beverage dispensary, the

20

Alcoholic Beverage Control Board shall determine if additional entrances

21

to the retail store are necessary for enforcement purposes, to meet

22

health and fire safety standards, or for the convenience of the public.

Sec. 04.20.020. LIMITATION ON CIVIL LIABILITY. A licensee, or the

25

employee or agent of a licensee, who furnishes intoxicating liquor to an

26

individual on premises licensed under this title may not be held civilly

27

liable for injuries resulting from the intoxication of that individual

28

unless the furnishing of intoxicating liquor occurred in violation of

29

AS 04.15.020(a), 04.15.060(e), or 04.15.080.
