6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to amendments to Title 4."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 04.10.040 is amended by adding a new section to article 1
9 to read:

10 Sec. 04.10.147. ENTRANCE TO PREMISES OF HOLDER OF RETAIL AND
11 BEVERAGE DISPENSARY LICENSES. When the holder of a retail license is
12 also a holder of a beverage dispensary license and the retail store
13 premises are contained within or adjacent to the premises of the bever-
14 age dispensary and the only public entrance to the retail store is by a
15 door or other means within the premises of the beverage dispensary, the
16 Alcoholic Beverage Control Board shall determine if additional entrances
17 to the retail store are necessary for enforcement purposes, to meet
18 health and fire safety standards, or for the convenience of the public.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 04.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

20 Sec. 04.20.020. LIMITATION ON CIVIL LIABILITY. A licensee, or the
21 employee or agent of a licensee, who furnishes intoxicating liquor to an
22 individual on premises licensed under this title may not be held civilly
23 liable for injuries resulting from the intoxication of that individual
24 unless the furnishing of intoxicating liquor occurred in violation of
25 AS 04.15.020(a), 04.15.060(e), or 04.15.080.
