6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state land and interests in land
7 owned by the state; and providing for an effective
8 date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 38.05.067(d) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

11 (d) In this section "veteran" means a person with

12 (1) 90 days or more of active service in the armed forces of
13 the United States who has been honorably discharged after having served
14 between

15 (A) April 6, 1917, and December 1, 1919,

16 (B) September 16, 1940, and December 31, 1947,

17 (C) June 27, 1950, and January 31, 1955, or

18 (D) August 4, 1964, and November 7, 1975; or

19 (2) not less than six years service in the Alaska Army Na-
20 tional Guard or the Alaska Air National Guard who has been honorably
21 discharged, or a person with less than six years of service because of
22 injury or disability incurred in the line of duty who has been honorably
23 discharged.

24 * Sec. 2. AS 38.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

25 Sec. 38.05.346. RELINQUISHMENT OF CERTAIN EASEMENTS CREATED BY
26 FEDERAL LAW. (a) The state relinquishes any right or claim for a
27 right-of-way for roads, roadways, highways, tramways, trails, bridges
28 and appurtenant structures reserved to the state under the Act of
29 June 30, 1932, ch. 320. sec. 5, as added July 24, 1947, ch. 313, 61

1 Stat. 418 if the right-of-way was used for a public purpose before
2 April 1, 1966.

3 (b) The state relinquishes any easement, right-of-way, right-of-
4 entry or similar encumbrance for highway purposes which was created by
5 the Secretary of the United States Department of the Interior under the
6 Act of June 25, 1910, 36 Stat. 847, and the Act of August 1, 1956, 70
7 Stat. 898 or Public Land Order 610 of August 10, 1949 as amended by
8 Public Land Order 757 of October 16, 1951, Public Land Order 1613 of
9 April 7, 1958 and United States Department of the Interior Order 2665 of
10 October 16, 1951, if that easement, right-of-way, right-of-entry or
11 similar encumbrance has not been used for a public purpose before the
12 effective date of this section.

13 * Sec. 3. Chapter 92, SLA 1966 is repealed.

14 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
15 070(c).
