5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act making special appropriations to various depart-
7 ments and agencies and the University of Alaska; and
8 amending certain appropriations made in 1980; and
9 providing for an effective date.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. The sum of \$4,938,419 is appropriated from the general fund
12 to the Department of Public Safety for emergency medical services.

13 * Sec. 2. The sum of \$1,454,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
14 the Department of Education for operation of state contract schools.

15 * Sec. 3. The sum of \$1,000,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
16 the Office of the Governor for a media effort on national lands legislation.

17 * Sec. 4. The sum of \$700,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
18 the Legislative Council for the joint gas pipeline committee interim expenses.

19 * Sec. 5. The sum of \$390,000 is appropriated from the renewable resources
20 development fund to the Alaska Agricultural Action Council for a reindeer
21 disease control study.

22 * Sec. 6. The sum of \$2,500,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
23 the Department of Community and Regional Affairs for full funding of fiscal
24 year 1981 municipal revenue sharing.

25 * Sec. 7. The sum of \$30,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the
26 Department of Public Safety to purchase an ambulance for the community of
27 Central.

28 * Sec. 8. The sum of \$298,900 is appropriated from the general fund to
29 the Department of Community and Regional Affairs as municipal lands trustee

1 for the Section 14(c), Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act land program
2 operations.

3 * Sec. 9. The sum of \$1,995,700 is appropriated from the general fund to
4 the Alaska Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission to create an Alaska fisheries
5 data center.

6 * Sec. 10. The sum of \$29,000 is appropriated from the general fund for
7 payment as a grant to the Municipality of Anchorage for the Chugiak Benefit
8 Association.

9 * Sec. 11. The sum of \$25,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
10 the Department of Education, Alaska Public Broadcasting Commission, for an
11 earth station and mini TV transmitter for Port Alexander.

12 * Sec. 12. The sum of \$56,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
13 the University of Alaska, Anchorage Community College for an Eagle River
14 extension center.

15 * Sec. 13. The sum of \$109,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
16 the University of Alaska, Kenai Peninsula Community College, for remodeling
17 cost overruns.

18 * Sec. 14. The sum of \$150,000 is appropriated from the general fund to
19 the Legislative Council for economic studies.

20 * Sec. 15. Section 39, Free Conference CS for House Bill No. 556, page
21 62, lines 6 - 7, is repealed and re-enacted to read:
