6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to campaign contributions."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 15.13.070(a) is amended to read:

9 (a) No person or group, including but not limited to all political  
10 committees, businesses, corporations, and labor unions may contribute to  
11 or expend more than \$1,000 a year on behalf of or in opposition to the  
12 competing candidates for each elective office or on behalf of or in  
13 opposition to a ballot proposition, ballot question, or ballot measure.  
14 Political parties and their subdivisions are not subject to the limita-  
15 tion prescribed in this subsection, but they are subject to the report-  
16 ing requirements prescribed by AS 15.13.040(b) and 15.13.110. Nothing  
17 in this chapter prohibits [(1)] a candidate from contributing more than  
18 \$1,000 of his own money to his own campaign [; OR (2) INDIVIDUALS OR  
19 GROUPS, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO ALL POLITICAL COMMITTEES, BUSI-  
20 NESSES, CORPORATIONS, AND LABOR UNIONS, FROM CONTRIBUTING TO OR EX-  
21 PENDING ON BEHALF OF A BALLOT PROPOSITION OR QUESTION MORE THAN \$1,000 A  
22 YEAR; HOWEVER, THESE CONTRIBUTIONS AND EXPENDITURES SHALL BE REPORTED IN  
23 ACCORDANCE WITH AS 15.13.040 AND 15.13.110].
