6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to limited entry permit applications."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 16.43.250 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

9 (d) If an applicant has experience in two or more fisheries fish-
10 ing for the same specific fishery resource while using the same specific
11 type of gear and his cumulative experience in those fisheries would
12 satisfy the requirements established for a priority classification under
13 (a) of this section and result in designation under (b) of this section
14 when applied to one of those fisheries, the applicant may select one of
15 the fisheries to which his cumulative experience will be credited and
16 the commission shall place the applicant in a priority classification
17 for the selected fishery. If an applicant selects one fishery under
18 this subsection, the experience credited to the fishery may not be
19 considered for the purpose of ranking the applicant under (a) - (c) of
20 this section for any other fishery.
