6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to limited entry permit applications."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 16.43.250 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

9 (d) If an individual has applied for two or more entry permits
10 under AS 16.43.260(d) for the same specific fishery resource and the
11 same specific type of gear, but has failed to qualify for an entry
12 permit for that type of fishery resource and gear, the individual may
13 credit his cumulative qualifications to the fishery for which he is most
14 qualified. The commission shall issue an entry permit to the individual
15 for the fishery if the individual's cumulative qualifications result in
16 placing the individual in a category designated in (b) of this section.
17 The qualifications credited to a fishery under this subsection may not
18 be considered for the purpose of ranking the applicant under (a) - (c)
19 of this section for any other fishery. The commission may not revoke
20 any permit previously issued notwithstanding the issuance of permits in
21 excess of the maximum number established under AS 16.43.230 - 16.43.240
22 as a result of this subsection.
