6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to fisheries business licenses."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 43.75.020 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 43.75.020. APPLICATION FOR LICENSE. (a) Application for a  
10 license shall be filed with the Department of Revenue and accompanied by  
11 an initial fee of \$25. A separate initial fee is required for each  
12 plant specified in the application covered by the license. The appli-  
13 cation shall contain the name of the applicant, the line of business to  
14 be licensed, place of business, and other facts which the department  
15 prescribes. The applicant shall attach to his application a statement  
16 of the payment of assessments due to qualified regional associations  
17 under AS 16.10.530. The applicant shall state that he agrees to pay the  
18 license tax, and that he will make a return and pay the tax at the time  
19 provided by law.

20 (b) Upon receipt of the application in proper form accompanied by  
21 the initial fee and proof of payment of assessments due to qualified  
22 regional associations under AS 16.10.530, the department shall issue the  
23 license as of the date the application is filed or mailed, and the  
24 applicant may carry on the business from the date the application was  
25 actually made.

27 (f) A person who wilfully fails to obtain a license, pay a tax,  
28 make a return, pay assessments due to qualified regional associations  
29 under AS 16.10.530, keep or display a record, or supply the information

1 at the time required by law or regulation, in violation of AS 43.75.-  
2 010 - 43.75.055, is, in addition to other penalties provided by law,  
3 guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction is punishable by a fine of  
4 not more than \$1,000, or by imprisonment for not more than one year, or  
5 by both, together with the cost of prosecution.

6 \* Sec. 3. AS 43.75.050(g) is amended to read:

7 (g) A person who wilfully makes and subscribes a financial state-  
8 ment regarding the payment of assessments owed to qualified regional  
9 associations under AS 16.10.530 or a return which he does not believe to  
10 be true and correct as to every material matter is guilty of a felony,  
11 and, upon conviction, is subject to the penalty prescribed for perjury.
