BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Sec. 29.18.215. MANAGEMENT OF GENERAL GRANT ENTITLEMENT LAND. (a)

The assembly or council shall manage and regulate the use and disposal  
14 of its general grant entitlement land.

(b) When the residents of a village within a borough petition, the  
borough assembly shall, by ordinance, establish an advisory land plan-  
ning and management committee composed of residents of the village or  
its immediate vicinity. The advisory committee shall review and submit  
recommendations to the planning commission and borough assembly with  
respect to the classification, zoning, use, or disposal of general grant  
land entitlements received by the borough under AS 29.18.201 - 29.18.213  
that are located in the vicinity of the village. No land or interest in  
land received by the borough under AS 29.18.201 - 29.18.213 and lying  
within six miles of the village may be classified, zoned, leased or sold  
by the borough unless the action proposed to be taken has the approval  
of a majority of the members of the advisory committee.

(c) In this section, "village" means an unincorporated community  
where at least 25 adult persons reside as a social unit, as determined  
by the commissioner of the Department of Community and Regional Affairs.
