6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to limited entry permits for hand-
7 trolling."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.43.150(h) is amended to read:

10 (h) Upon the death of an entry permit holder, the permanent permit
11 shall be transferred by the commission directly to the surviving spouse
12 by right of survivorship unless a contrary intent is manifested or
13 unless the permanent permit was issued for handtrolling. When no spouse
14 survives, the rights of the decedent pass as part of his estate unless
15 the rights relate to a permanent permit that was issued for hand-
16 trolling. A permanent permit issued for handtrolling shall be trans-
17 ferred to the commission upon the death of the permit holder.

18 * Sec. 2. AS 16.43.150 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

19 (i) Failure to verify to the commission the landing of at least
20 500 pounds of fish per season under a limited entry permit for hand-
21 trolling results in a forfeiture of the entry permit to the commission,
22 except as waived by the commission for good cause. The commission shall
23 adopt regulations in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act
24 (AS 44.62) establishing permissible methods of verifying a landing under
25 this subsection.

26 * Sec. 3. AS 16.43.170 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

27 (e) Notwithstanding the provisions of (a) - (c) of this section,
28 an entry permit for handtrolling is transferable only to the commission,
29 except as provided in AS 16.43.180(a).
