6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state regulation of fireworks; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 18.72.020(a)(1) is amended to read:

10 (1) the person has submitted to the state fire marshal a
11 policy, or a certified true copy of a policy, of public liability [AND
12 PRODUCTS LIABILITY] insurance, including both accident and occurrence
13 coverage, provided by the wholesale company selling [TO THE] fireworks
14 to the person [RETAILER,] in the amount of at least \$200,000 [\$300,000]
15 for bodily injury or death and at least \$50,000 [\$100,000] property
16 damage [, UPON WHICH POLICY THE STATE AND ALL GOVERNMENTAL SUBDIVISIONS
17 OF THE STATE] and the person is [PERMIT HOLDER SHALL BE] named as an
18 insured party upon the policy [ADDITIONAL INSUREDS] and the policy is
19 [WHICH SHALL BE] continuously in force while the person [PERMIT HOLDER]
20 is engaged in the retail sale of fireworks, and

21 * Sec. 2. AS 18.72.030(a) is amended to read:

22 (a) A person who desires to sell fireworks at wholesale in the
23 state shall first make verified application for a license to the state
24 fire marshal on forms provided by him. The application shall be accom-
25 panied by an annual license fee of \$100 [\$500].

26 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
27 070(c).
