6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the membership of the Wood-Tikchik  
7 State Park Management Council; and providing for an  
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 41.20.480(b) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

11 (b) A nine-member Wood-Tikchik State Park Management Council is  
12 created and shall be appointed by the governor. Management council  
13 members may, subject to appropriations, receive the same per diem and  
14 travel expenses authorized for members of state boards. The governor  
15 shall appoint the council as follows:

16 (1) each of the following shall submit three nominations:

- 17 (A) the village council of Koliganek;  
18 (B) the village council of New Stuyahok;  
19 (C) the village council of Aleknagik;  
20 (D) the city council of Dillingham;  
21 (E) the Bristol Bay Native Association, Inc.;  
22 (F) the commissioner of natural resources;  
23 (G) the commissioner of fish and game;

24 (2) the governor shall appoint one of the nominees submitted  
25 by each council or person under (1) of this subsection;

26 (3) the governor shall appoint two public members, one of  
27 whom owns, manages, or participates in a business concerned with tourism  
28 and the development of lodges and other facilities for hunting, fishing,  
29 and recreational activities in the park.

1 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-  
2 070(c).
