6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the survey and improvement of state
7 land."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 38.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 38.05.361. SURVEY AND PLATTING OF STATE LAND. (a) A pro-
11 fessional land surveyor registered to practice under AS 08.48 shall
12 supervise the location and monumentation of boundaries, the platting,
13 subdivision and the preparation and perpetuation of maps, plats for
14 recordation, field note records, and property descriptions of state
15 land.

16 (b) A change in the boundary of a lease, easement, right-of-way or
17 other similar agreement which allows the use and improvement of state
18 land shall be documented by a recorded plat.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 35.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

20 Sec. 35.10.022. IMPROVEMENTS ON STATE LAND. (a) The location,
21 design, and construction of publicly financed improvements on state land
22 which cost more than \$100,000 shall be under the supervision of a person
23 registered to practice under AS 08.48.

24 (b) In this section,

25 (1) "improvements" includes, but is not limited to, onshore
26 or offshore oil drilling or pumping operations, roads, bridges, pipe-
27 lines, seismic lines, logging and mining operations, dams, buildings and
28 electric power transmission lines; and

29 (2) "publicly financed" improvements includes all improve-

ments financed by the state with state or federal funds, and all im-
provements constructed by instrumentalities of the state.
