5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act creating the Alaska Safety Advisory Commission."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 18.60 is amended by adding new sections to read:

9 ARTICLE 11. ALASKA SAFETY ADVISORY COMMISSION.

10 Sec. 18.60.840. ALASKA SAFETY ADVISORY COMMISSION. There is
11 created in the Department of Labor the Alaska Safety Advisory Com-
12 mission, referred to in AS 18.60.840 - 18.60.880 as the commission.

13 Sec. 18.60.850. APPOINTMENT AND TERM OF OFFICE OF MEMBERS. (a)
14 The commission consists of six members representing industry, four
15 members representing labor, and five members representing government.

16 (b) Each member of the commission is to be appointed by the
17 governor for a term of two years and until his or her successor is
18 appointed and qualified. An appointment to a vacancy is for the
19 unexpired term. A person may be reappointed by the governor for addi-
20 tional terms. Members serve at the pleasure of the governor.

21 Sec. 18.60.860. DUTIES. The commission shall:

22 (1) organize and hold an annual governor's safety conference
23 to bring together citizens interested in safety and health matters;

24 (2) assist the executive departments in matters concerning
25 occupational, transportation, public, and private safety and health;
26 and

27 (3) provide assistance to the governor and the legislature
28 in the achievement of a coordinated state policy and program for the
29 safety and health of Alaskans.

1 Sec. 18.60.870. ELECTION OF OFFICERS. The commission shall
2 elect a president and a secretary from among its members, each to
3 serve for a term not to exceed two years. The commissioner of labor
4 or his designee shall serve as the executive secretary of the commission.

5 Sec. 18.60.880. EXPENSES AND SALARY. Members of the commission
6 shall serve without compensation, per diem, or an expense allowance.
