For an Act entitled: "An Act creating the Alaska Safety Advisory Commission."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 18.60 is amended by adding new sections to read:

ARTICLE 11. ALASKA SAFETY ADVISORY COMMISSION.

Sec. 18.60.840. ALASKA SAFETY ADVISORY COMMISSION. There is created in the Department of Labor the Alaska Safety Advisory Commission.

Sec. 18.60.850. APPOINTMENT AND TERM OF OFFICE OF MEMBERS. (a) The commission consists of 10 members representing a cross-section of industry, four members representing labor, and five members representing federal, state, and local government.

(b) Each member of the commission shall be appointed by the governor for a term of two years and until his successor is appointed and qualified. An appointment to a vacancy is for the unexpired term. A member may be reappointed by the governor for additional terms. Members serve at the pleasure of the governor.

Sec. 18.60.860. DUTIES. The commission shall

(1) organize and hold an annual governor's safety conference to bring together citizens interested in safety and health matters;

(2) make recommendations to the executive departments of state government on matters concerning occupational, transportation, public, and private safety and health; and

(3) make recommendations to the governor and the legislature on the achievement of a coordinated state policy and program for the

safety and health of residents of the state.

Sec. 18.60.870. ELECTION OF OFFICERS. The commission shall elect a president and a secretary from among its members, each to serve for a term not to exceed two years. The commissioner of labor or his designee shall serve as the executive secretary of the commission.

Sec. 18.60.880. EXPENSES AND SALARY. Members of the commission serve without compensation but are entitled to per diem and travel expenses authorized by law for state boards and commissions.

Sec. 18.60.890. DEFINITION. In AS 18.60.840 - 18.60.890, "commission" means the Alaska Safety Advisory Commission.
