6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the establishment of resource
7 management areas and establishing the Mulchatna River
8 Resource Management Area."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. It is the purpose of this Act to provide a land classifica-
11 tion category to accommodate management of public land containing of valuable
12 surface and subsurface resources for a wide variety of compatible uses and
13 purposes in accordance with principles of multiple use.

14 * Sec. 2. AS 38.04 is amended by adding new sections to read:

15 ARTICLE 3A. RESOURCE MANAGEMENT AREAS.

16 Sec. 38.04.100. MANAGEMENT OF RESOURCE MANAGEMENT AREAS. (a) The
17 commissioner shall develop and implement a management plan for the
18 renewable and nonrenewable resources within a resource management area
19 described in AS 38.04.110. Before the management plan is implemented or
20 amended the commissioner shall hold hearings under AS 44.62.

21 (b) The management plan developed by the commissioner for a re-
22 source management area shall provide for multiple land use management
23 consistent with the specific objectives described in the plan. The
24 objectives may vary according to the resources identified in the land
25 use plan. Resource management land may be used for purposes related to,
26 or compatible with, the management of those resources identified in the
27 resource management area land use plan.
