6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Chena River Recreation Area."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. Section 3, ch. 26, SLA 1967 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 3. INCOMPATIBLE USES PROHIBITED. (a) The commissioner of  
10 natural resources shall designate by regulation incompatible uses within  
11 the boundaries of the Chena River Recreation Area in accordance with the  
12 requirements of [SEC. 1 OF] this Act, and those incompatible uses desig-  
13 nated shall be prohibited or restricted, as provided by regulation.

14 \* Sec. 2. Section 3, ch. 26, SLA 1967 is amended by adding a new subsec-  
15 tion to read:

16 (b) The following uses may not be designated as incompatible uses:

17 (1) mineral leasing and mining under AS 38.05.135 - 38.05.-

19 (2) the taking of fur bearing animals;

20 (3) the use of existing roads and trails by traditional means  
21 of transportation, including mechanical equipment;

22 (4) the use of any vehicles, including all-terrain vehicles,  
23 in sections 4, 5, 8, 9, 16, 17, 18, and 33, T1N, R6E, Fairbanks Meridian,  
24 and in the portions of sections 19 and 20, T1N, R6E, Fairbanks Meridian,  
25 north of Chena Hot Springs Road.
