2 HOUSE BILL NO. 518

3 IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

4 ELEVENTH LEGISLATURE - SECOND SESSION

5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act establishing the Fisheries Development Commit-
7 tee; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. FISHERIES DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE. There is established the
10 Fisheries Development Committee as a temporary committee to assist the legis-
11 lature.

12 * Sec. 2. MEMBERSHIP. (a) The Fisheries Development Committee is com-
13 posed of eight members, selected as follows:

14 (1) two members selected by the presiding officer of each house of
15 the legislature; and

16 (2) two members selected by the chairman of the resources commit-
17 tee of each house of the legislature.

18 (b) Vacancies in committee membership shall be filled in the manner
19 provided in (a) of this section.

20 (c) Members selected for the committee may be legislators or other
21 residents of the state.

22 * Sec. 3. COMPENSATION. The members of the Fisheries Development Com-
23 mittee do not receive compensation for their services, but are entitled to
24 the same travel pay and per diem as state officials and employees.

25 * Sec. 4. CHAIRMAN AND VICE-CHAIRMAN. The Fisheries Development Com-
26 mittee shall elect a chairman and vice-chairman from the members of the
27 committee.

28 * Sec. 5. MEETINGS. The Fisheries Development Committee shall meet at
29 least once every two months to carry out its duties under this Act. The

1 first meeting of the committee shall be convened at the call of the speaker
2 of the house not later than 20 days following appointment of the committee.

3 * Sec. 6. DUTIES. The Fisheries Development Committee shall

4 (1) receive and review reports concerning industry investment in
5 bottomfish;

6 (2) hold public hearings and meetings and conduct research to
7 determine the most likely types of industry investment in bottomfish in
8 Alaska;

9 (3) complete a report which includes the findings of its research
10 and any recommendations it may have for assisting industry investment in
11 bottomfish in Alaska;

12 (4) furnish a copy of its report to the presiding officer of each
13 house of the legislature not later than February 1, 1981.

14 * Sec. 7. TERMINATION. The Fisheries Development Committee terminates
15 February 28, 1981.

16 * Sec. 8. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect immediately in accor-
17 dance with AS 01.10.070(c).
