6 For an Act entitled: "An Act amending the Uniform Interstate Compact on  
7 Juveniles; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 47.15.010 is amended by adding a new article as follows:

10 ARTICLE XVII

11 AMENDMENT TO THE INTERSTATE COMPACT ON JUVENILES;

12 INTERSTATE RENDITION OF JUVENILES ALLEGED TO BE DELINQUENT

13 (a) This amendment provides additional remedies, and is binding  
14 among and between those party states which specifically execute it.  
15 This amendment is also binding upon this state, when the juvenile is  
16 found in this state, regardless of whether the state requesting the  
17 return of the juvenile has executed this amendment, so long as an oth-  
18 erwise proper application under the provisions of this compact has  
19 been made.

20 (b) All provisions and procedures of Articles V and VI of this  
21 compact apply to any juvenile charged with being a delinquent by rea-  
22 son of a violation of any criminal law. Any juvenile charged with be-  
23 ing a delinquent by reason of violating any criminal law must be re-  
24 turned to the requesting state upon a requisition to the state where  
25 the juvenile may be found. A petition in such a case must be filed in  
26 a court of competent jurisdiction in the requesting state where the  
27 violation of criminal law is alleged to have been committed. The  
28 petition may be filed regardless of whether the juvenile has left the  
29 state before or after the filing of the petition. The requisition

1 described in Article V of this compact must be forwarded by the judge  
2 of the court in which the petition has been filed.
