6 For an Act entitled: "An Act appropriating for the operating and capital
7 expenses of the state government; and providing for an
8 effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. Included within the general fund amounts appropriated ac-
11 cording to the schedules in secs.10 and 11 of this Act, the following amounts
12 are from the unreserved special accounts in the general fund:

	Operating	Capital
13 Highway Fuel Tax Account	\$19,000,000	
14 Aviation Fuel Tax Account	3,700,000	
15 Watercraft Fuel Tax Account		\$3,200,000

16 * Sec. 2. A sum is appropriated from the general fund necessary to pay
17 interest on revenue anticipation notes issued by the commissioner of revenue
18 under AS 43.08.010.

19 * Sec. 3. Federal or other program receipts which exceed the amounts
20 appropriated in this Act are appropriated conditioned upon compliance with
21 the program review provisions of AS 37.07.080(h).

22 * Sec. 4. If federal or other program receipts exceed the estimates
23 appropriated by this Act, the appropriation from state funds for the affected
24 program may be reduced by the amount of the excess if the reductions are not
25 inconsistent with applicable federal statutes.

26 * Sec. 5. If program receipts fall short of the estimates appropriated by
27 this Act, the affected appropriation shall be reduced by the amount of the
28 shortfall in receipts.

ADD: "Capital Site Planning Commission 750,000" to be shown as an appropriation item, appropriation fund source is the general fund.

It is the intent of the Legislature that the Capital Site Planning Commission submit a report to the Legislature by February 1, 1981. The report shall contain a detailed plan for development of the capital site in Willow that would be an alternative and lower cost plan than previously submitted. Cost estimates shall show separately costs due to relocation and those due to expected increases in the size of government. Estimates shall include a cost study of retaining the capital in Juneau. The Commission may also expend funds for the purpose of meeting federal requirements for environmental studies.
