6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the issuance of general obliga-  
7 tion bonds in the amount of \$18,787,500 for the purpose  
8 of paying the cost of energy conservation, code up-  
9 grade, and architectural barrier removal for state  
10 facilities; and providing for an effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 \* Section 1. For the purpose of paying the cost of energy conservation,  
13 code upgrade, and architectural barrier removal for state facilities, general  
14 obligation bonds of the state in the principal amount of not more than  
15 \$18,787,500 shall be issued and sold. The full faith, credit, and resources  
16 of the state are pledged to the payment of the principal of and interest and  
17 redemption premium, if any, on these bonds. These bonds shall be issued  
18 under the provision of AS 37.15 as those provisions read at the time of  
19 issuance.

20 \* Sec. 2. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the qualified  
21 voters of the state, a special fund of the state to be known as the "1980  
22 Facilities Upgrade Construction Fund" shall be established, to which shall be  
23 credited the proceeds of the sale of bonds described in sec. 1 of this Act  
24 except for accrued interest and premiums.

25 \* Sec. 3. The sum of \$18,787,500 is appropriated from the "1980 Facili-  
26 ties Upgrade Construction Fund" to the Department of Transportation and  
27 Public Facilities to be allocated in accordance with the following projects  
28 and estimates subject to reallocation between projects in accordance with  
29 AS 37.07.080(e):
