5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the issuance of general obliga-
7 tion bonds in the amount of \$63,651,000 for the purpose
8 of paying the cost of capital improvements for educa-
9 tion facilities, teacher housing, library facilities,
10 and University of Alaska facilities; and providing for
11 an effective date."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

13 * Section 1. For the purpose of paying the cost of capital improvements
14 for education facilities, teacher housing, library facilities, and University
15 of Alaska facilities, general obligation bonds of the state in the principal
16 amount of not more than \$63,651,000 shall be issued and sold. The full
17 faith, credit, and resources of the state are pledged to the payment of the
18 principal of and interest and redemption premium, if any, on these bonds.
19 These bonds shall be issued under the provisions of AS 37.15 as those pro-
20 visions read at the time of issuance.

21 * Sec. 2. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the qualified
22 voters of the state, a special fund of the state to be known as the "1980
23 Education, Library, and University of Alaska Facilities Construction Fund"
24 shall be established, to which shall be credited the proceeds of the sale of
25 bonds described in sec. 1 of this Act except for accrued interest and pre-
26 miums.

27 * Sec. 3. The sum of \$500,000 is appropriated from the "1980 Education,
28 Library, and University of Alaska Facilities Construction Fund" to the De-
29 partment of Education for library construction grants for community libraries

1 statewide.

2 * Sec. 4. The sum of \$24,881,000 is appropriated from the "1980 Educa-
3 tion, Library, and University of Alaska Facilities Construction Fund" to the
4 Department of Transportation and Public Facilities, in the amounts and for
5 the projects listed in this section:

8 * Sec. 5. The sum of \$1,000,000 is appropriated from the "1980 Education,
9 Library, and University of Alaska Facilities Construction Fund" to the Depart-
10 ment of Transportation and Public Facilities for teacher housing statewide.

11 * Sec. 6. The amount of \$37,270,000 is appropriated from the "1980 Educa-
12 tion, Library, and University of Alaska Facilities Construction Fund" to the
13 University of Alaska in the amounts and for the projects listed in this
14 section:

8 * Sec. 7. The appropriations for projects made in this Act may be re-
9 appropriated among the projects by law.

10 * Sec. 8. If the issuance of these bonds is authorized by the qualified
11 voters of the state, the amount of \$223,000 or as much of that amount as is
12 found necessary is appropriated from the general fund of the state to the
13 state bond committee to carry out the provisions of this Act and to pay
14 expenses incident to the sale and issuance of the bonds authorized in this
15 Act. The amounts expended from the appropriation authorized by this section
16 shall be reimbursed to the general fund from the proceeds of the sale of the
17 bonds authorized by this Act.

18 * Sec. 9. The amount withdrawn from the public facility planning fund for
19 the purpose of advance planning for the improvements financed under this Act
20 shall be reimbursed from the proceeds of the sale of bonds authorized by this
21 Act.

22 * Sec. 10. The question whether the bonds authorized in this Act are to
23 be issued shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the state at the next
24 general election and shall read substantially as follows:

25 Proposition

26 State General Obligation Education, Library, and University
27 of Alaska Facilities Construction Bonds \$63,651,000
28 Shall the State of Alaska issue its general obligation bonds in the
29 principal amount of not more than \$63,651,000 for the purpose of

1 paying the cost of capital improvements for education, library, and
2 University of Alaska facilities?
