6 For an Act entitled: "An Act creating the Tugidak Island critical habitat
7 area."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.20.230 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

10 (12) Tugidak Island: All land, including tide and submerged
11 land, and water to the minus five-foot elevation known as Tugidak Island
12 and contained in the following description:

13 (A) Township 41 South, Ranges 33 - 34 West, Seward
14 Meridian;

15 (B) Township 42 South, Ranges 33 - 35 West, Seward
16 Meridian;

17 (C) Township 43 South, Ranges 34 - 35 West, Seward
18 Meridian.

19 * Sec. 2. In the Tugidak Island critical habitat area established in
20 sec. 1 of this Act, existing cabins may remain, present subsistence and
21 recreational uses may continue, present commercial uses, such as seal hunt-
22 ing, if appropriate, may continue, and individual uses such as placer mining
23 may continue.
