6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the protection of the public  
7 health."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 17.20 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 17.20.345. LIMITATION OF CIVIL AND CRIMINAL LIABILITY OF  
11 DONORS OF FOOD. (a) A person who in good faith donates food for use or  
12 distribution by a nonprofit organization may not be liable for civil  
13 damages or subject to criminal prosecution resulting from adulteration  
14 or misbranding of the donated food, unless the adulteration or mis-  
15 branding results from intentional or grossly negligent conduct.

16 (b) A nonprofit organization may request that the commissioner  
17 inspect donated food to determine if the food is adulterated or mis-  
18 branded.

19 (c) In this section "grossly negligent conduct" means the in-  
20 tentional failure to perform a duty with reckless disregard of con-  
21 sequences that affect the life or property of another.

22 \* Sec. 2. AS 44.29 is amended by adding a new section to article 1 to  
23 read:

24 Sec. 44.29.030. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY OF COMMISSIONER. The  
25 commissioner of health and social services may delegate to the Depart-  
26 ment of Environmental Conservation the performance of a duty or  
27 authority of the commissioner under AS 17.05, AS 17.20, or AS 18.05.040.
