For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the maximum length of salmon net  
7 vessels."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 16.05.835 is amended to read:

10

Sec. 16.05.835. MAXIMUM LENGTH OF SALMON NET [SEINE] VESSELS. (a)

11

No salmon seine vessel may be longer than 50 feet, official Coast Guard  
12 register length, [AND 58 FEET OVERALL LENGTH] except

13

(1) vessels that have fished for salmon with seines in waters  
14 of the state before January 1, 1962, as 50-foot, official Coast Guard  
15 register length vessels; and

16

(2) vessels that fish for salmon with seines in the south-  
17 eastern waters of the state only.

18

(b) No vessel used to fish for salmon with a gill net in the  
19 waters of the state within Bristol Bay may be longer than 32 feet, offi-  
20 cial Coast Guard register length.

21

(c) In (a) of this section, "southeastern waters of the state"  
22 means the waters of the state south and east of a line running 225 de-  
23 grees true through Cape St. Elias.
