6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing licensed grocery stores to sell  
7 beer and wine."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 04.10.020 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (p) grocery license.

11 \* Sec. 2. AS 04.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

12 Sec. 04.10.105. GROCERY LICENSE. (a) A grocery license autho-  
13 rizes the holder to sell beer and wine in the original package on the  
14 premises. The consumption of intoxicating liquor on premises licensed  
15 under this section is prohibited. Sales made to any one person in any  
16 one sale are limited to 20 wine gallons. The grocery license fee is  
17 \$600.

18 (b) In this section, "grocery store" means an establishment which

19 (1) has no less than 1,000 square feet of space in an en-  
20 closed room where stock is displayed and offered for sale;

21 (2) maintains an inventory of edible items intended for human  
22 consumption having a wholesale value of no less than \$2,000 and con-  
23 sisting of a variety of items of the type normally sold in grocery  
24 stores;

25 (3) has gross sales of edible items of no less than \$2,000 a  
26 month;

27 (4) has sales of gasoline, exclusive of federal and state  
28 taxes, that do not exceed two and one-half times the sales of all other  
29 products, exclusive of alcoholic beverages and sales taxes, and is

otherwise not primarily a marketer of petroleum products; and  
(5) does not provide service with any sale of petroleum  
products.
