For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the power of a second class borough
7 to establish a service area; and providing for an
8 effective date."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 29.48.010(9) is amended to read:

(9) to acquire, manage, control, use and dispose of real and

12

personal property for a purpose authorized under this title, federal

13

law, or other law, or in accordance with such law, and irrespective of

14

whether or not the property is situated within or outside the municipal

15

boundaries; [THIS POWER INCLUDES THE POWER OF A SECOND CLASS BOROUGH TO

16

EXPEND, FOR ANY PURPOSE AUTHORIZED BY LAW, MONEY RECEIVED FROM THE

17

DISPOSAL OF LAND IN A SERVICE AREA CREATED UNDER AS 29.63.090(f);]

* Sec. 2. AS 29.63.090(a) is amended to read:

(a) Service areas to provide special services within a borough may

20

be established, operated, altered or abolished by the assembly by or-

21

dinance. Special services include services not provided on an areawide

22

basis within the borough or the borough area outside cities or a higher

23

or different level of service than that provided on an areawide basis or

24

in the borough area outside cities. In a first class borough the as-

25

sembly may exercise within a service area any power granted a first

26

class city by general law. A [EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN (f) OF THIS SEC-

27

TION, A] second class borough may exercise within a service area the

28

powers approved at incorporation, conferred by AS 29.48.020, or acquired

29

under AS 29.38.030 [GRANTED A FIRST CLASS CITY BY GENERAL LAW] but the

1 exercise of the powers must be approved by a majority of the qualified
2 voters residing within the service area and voting on the question at a
3 regular or special election.

4 * Sec. 3. AS 29.63.090(f) is repealed.

5 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
6 070(c).
