6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring the commissioner of natural resources
7 to establish advisory committees to advise him con-
8 cerning land disposal programs; and providing for an
9 effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 38.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

12 Sec. 38.05.048. ADVISORY COMMITTEES. The commissioner shall adopt
13 regulations which establish an advisory committee for each organized
14 borough and for each area of the unorganized borough in which he intends
15 to dispose of state land. The advisory committees shall consist of
16 persons residing in the borough or area of the unorganized borough who
17 are well informed on the state land resources in the borough or area.
18 The commissioner shall set the number and terms of members of the advi-
19 sory committees and shall designate one member of each advisory commit-
20 tee as chairman. The commissioner shall authorize the chairman of each
21 advisory committee to hold public hearings to determine the availability
22 of and the method for disposal of state land in the borough or area in
23 the unorganized borough.

24 * Sec. 2. AS 38.05.050 is amended to read:

25 Sec. 38.05.050. FIXING SALE. The commissioner, after consulting
26 with [UPON RECOMMENDATION OF] the appropriate advisory committee [DIREC-
27 TOR], shall determine the lands to be disposed of [SOLD], the limita-
28 tions and conditions which attach to the land disposed of [LANDS SOLD],
29 and the method of disposal [TERMS OF THE SALE]. The director shall fix

1 the time of disposal [SALE] and the manner of giving notice of the
2 land disposal [SALE]. A disposal of state land [THE SALE] shall take
3 place at the time and location specified in the notice of land disposal
4 [SALE] and within the recording district where the land [PROPERTY] is
5 located or an adjacent recording district.

6 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-
7 070(c).
